1.0 POLICY:

Vacancies for members of the board of education will be filled by appointment by the board as required by Oklahoma state law. A person appointed to fill a vacancy in the first half of the term of office will serve only until the next succeeding election, at which time the office which they hold will be placed on the ballot for the balance of the unexpired term.

A person elected to fill an unexpired term will begin the term at the next meeting of the board of education following certification by the election board of the election results.

A person appointed to fill a vacancy after the first half of the term of office for the board position will serve for the balance of the unexpired term.

No person will be appointed to a board of education who does not meet the eligibility qualifications needed to be a candidate for such position, as provided for by law.

If the board does not fill a vacant board seat within sixty (60) days of the date the board declares the seat vacant, the board will call a special election to fill the vacancy for the unexpired term.
