

## **Possible COVID-19 Symptoms Provided by CDC**

Reported symptoms have ranged from mild to severe for confirmed COVID-19 cases. The following symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure and include:

- Fever of 100.4 degrees or above
- Chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

## **When to Seek Emergency Medical Attention**

If a person is displaying any of the following symptoms, call 911 to transport them to an emergency room. Notify the dispatcher that you are seeking care for someone who may have COVID-19

- Trouble breathing
- Persistent pain or pressure in the chest
- New confusion
- Inability to wake or stay awake
- Bluish lips or face
